## WIDE RANGE OF EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES

UWM offers **more than 70 first-cycle and long-cycle degree programmes** across a wide range of disciplines – from the humanities and social sciences to engineering, life sciences and medicine.

The University combines strong academic traditions with modern, interdisciplinary programmes tailored to the needs of the contemporary labour market. In addition, UWM offers over **50 postgraduate programmes and a doctoral school**, providing opportunities for further academic and professional development.

## MODERN TEACHING INFRASTRUCTURE

Students and doctoral candidates benefit from modern teaching and research facilities, including:

- specialized scientific laboratories
- simulation centres and specialist laboratories
- modern lecture halls and libraries
- sports and recreational infrastructure

The University also develops cooperation with public institutions, enterprises and international partners, enabling students to gain experience through **internships, placements and participation in research projects.**

## SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH AND INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION

Researchers at the University of Warmia and Mazury conduct studies in many fields of science, including:

- medical and biological sciences
- biotechnology and food technology
- environmental protection and sustainable development
- social sciences and humanities
- modern technologies and engineering sciences

The University's growing international reputation is reflected in global rankings. UWM is listed in the Center for World University Rankings (CWUR), placing it among the top 7% of universities worldwide. The University is also a co-founder and deputy leader of the **ChallengeEU European Universities Alliance** and, since 2025, has been part of the prestigious European Universities initiative.

## DEVELOPMENT OF SKILLS AND CAREERS

The University supports the development of students and early-career researchers through:

- Doctoral School
- student research clubs
- participation in research projects
- academic mobility programmes and international cooperation
- development of professional and research competencies.

## LEARNING IN AN INTERNATIONAL ENVIRONMENT

The University of Warmia and Mazury educates students, doctoral candidates and participants of postgraduate programmes, supported by nearly two thousand academic staff working across 15 faculties, the School of Public Health and the Branch Campus in Elk.

Since its establishment, the University has educated nearly 165,000 graduates who today work in academia, business, public administration, healthcare, education and the creative sector – both in Poland and internationally.
