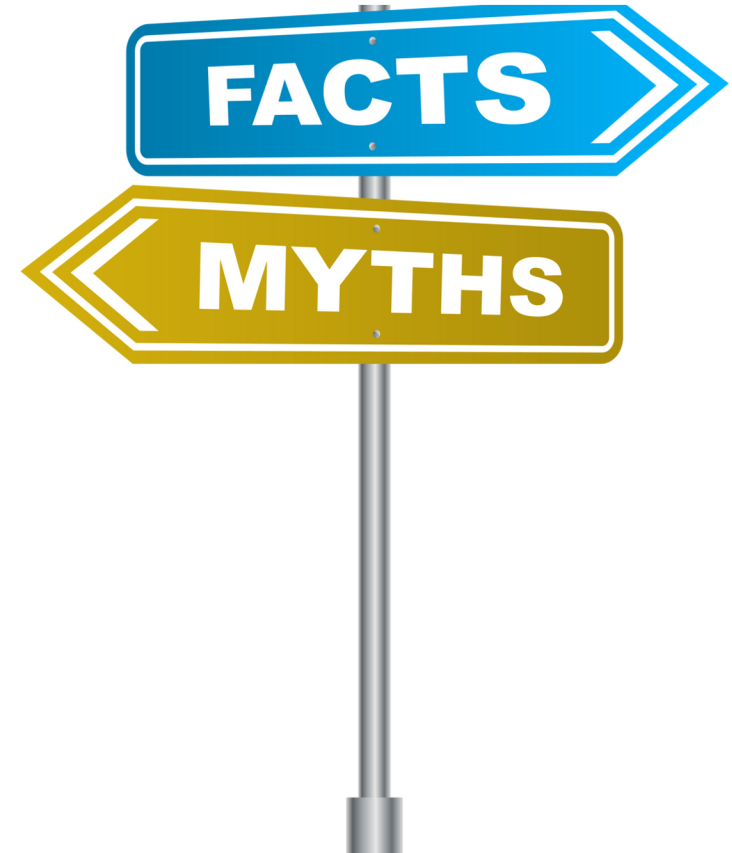

RESILIENCE LAB: MEDIA FOR SOCIAL CHANGE

Course Description

In an era of information overload and media polarization, building resilience to disinformation is essential for social well-being and democratic participation. This course introduces students to the ways media shape public opinion and how they can be used as powerful tools for driving social change. The course helps students develop critical awareness and creative strategies for promoting responsible media engagement.

Through workshops, creative media projects and lectures, students learn to analyze sources of information, verify information credibility, and design media content that promotes critical thinking and positive social impact. The course combines theoretical perspectives on disinformation and social change with practice in media production, empowering students to become creative, critical, and resilient media creators and consumers.



Learning Outcomes

By the end of the course, you will be able to:

- Analyze media messages and understand how they shape public perception
- Verify information and identify disinformation
- Develop creative and responsible media content that fosters positive social change
- Build resilience to disinformation and manipulative media narratives
