LECTURES: 1. Real estate – description, 2. Preparation of real estate for presentation, 3. Personal capacity of the parties to the transaction, 4. Acquisition of real estate by foreigners, 5. Running a real estate office, 6. Real estate on the primary and secondary market in Poland.
