Substantive content

CLASSES: Examples of negative and positive development of rural space; Development of an application for permission to change the use of agricultural and forestry land for other purposes; Shaping the agroforestry border - inventory of the area in terms of afforestation; Habitat plot development project.

LECTURES: Sustainable development of rural areas; procedure for converting agricultural and forestry land for other purposes; Agri-forest border, Afforestation of agricultural land, Acquisition and absorption of EU funds and rural development, habitat plot (functionality, development concept, investment and construction process).

Learning purpose: Understanding the procedure for drawing up applications for consent to a change of purpose in the local spatial development plan and indication of guidelines leading to the rational development of rural space.
