Substantive content

CLASSES: 1. Sketches of the human skeleton, sketches of the animal skeleton. 2. Model sketches. 3. Sketches of fragments of the human body. 4. Comparison of the skeleton and the model in the drawing. 5. A half-study studio drawing, including specific model movement and musculoskeletal system. 6 Study of a gypsum model.

Learning purpose: Mastering elementary knowledge of proportions and the structure of the human body. The student knows the skeleton and structure of the human body. Anatomically correct study of the human figure.
