Substantive content

CLASSES: Sketches and studies for which the starting point is the observed reality and creative transformation of the selected topic and issue. Model study. A painting interpretation of pairs of opposites: static - dynamic, flat - spatial, synthesis - expression.

Learning purpose:(Acquaintance with selected artistic conventions in the tradition of painting. The use of artistic stylistic measures to shape and transform reality in the image. Observation and analysis of the human figure and the ability to present it on canvas.
