Substantive content

CLASSES: The basics of camera settings and light setup. Work with black&white range area. Basics of photography printing. Basics work in photographic darkroom.

Learning purpose: Using advanced camera settings and light setup. Work with color range area. Basics of postproduction in Camera RAW and Lightroom.

On completion of the study programme the graduate will gain:

Knowledge: The aim of education is to make the student aware of the role of photography in the modern world of art and media. Its role in the interpretation and definition of the modern world and the function that should be played in the age of virtual communication. It is important to familiarize the student with the work of outstanding photographic practices and, in summary, to make them aware of the works that photographic art has as a field of authors of artistic assessments. Exercises: To familiarize the student with practical knowledge of the principles of digital camera operation. Learn to study a complementary photographic image component based on classical composition rules. Practical exercises to master the distribution of light emitted by professional studio lighting. (basics). Understanding the basic principles of studio lighting.
