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#### Substantive content

CLASSES: Developing the ability to communicate freely in various situations in combination with the active and systematic enrichment of vocabulary on the basis of the analyzed written texts covering a wide range of subject areas in the field of tourism; target level: B2 according to the Common European Framework for Languages; making use of the vast range of multimedia resources; lexical exercises, eg. word formation, synonyms and antonyms as well as collocations, giving interactive multimedia presentations

Learning purpose: work on vocabulary on the B2 level according to the CEFRL enabling students to express themselves freely on topics related to tourism
