CLASSES: An academic paragraph: 1.structure: topic sentence, controlling idea, supporting sentences, concluding sentence; 2.planning: basic/extended outline; 4. topic: narrowing, 4. .unity, coherence, cohesion; 5.punctuation; 6.register:formal/informal 7. elements of style; 8. purpose, audience; 9. types: narrative, descriptive, definition, process, comparison/contrast, cause/effect; a paragraph based on facts and figures: diagrams, pie charts, tables, graphs

Learning purpose: A student is able to write an academic paragraph about 150 words long, based on selective information, using appropriate style, register, grammar structures and a varied vocabulary.
