Substantive content

LECTURES: Lectures are a presentation of issues that are part of fundamental pastoral theology: her nature, subject, method and models. The concept of the model and its application in (pastoral) theology will be discussed, followed by individual models of pastoral activity: kerygmatic, mistagogical and therapeutic, as well as hospitality and *communio*. The presentation of individual models includes the social context (invocation), theological tradition and practical consequences. The presentation of each model ends with its evaluation.

Learning purpose: The aim of the lectures is to familiarize students with the basics of modern models of the pastoral activity of the Church, so that they can participate in her pastoral work in a more mature way, as well as acquire the skills of introducing others to the Christian faith.

On completion of the study programme the graduate will gain:

Knowledge: Student describes the activities of the Roman Church, describing them with the help of models

Skills: Student solves basic pastoral problems and makes a critical assessment of the Church's activities

Social Competencies: The student uses his theological knowledge in pastoral practice in collaboration with others
